## **Breathing holes for appliances**

<u>To put breathing holes in the appliance</u>, use a Brasseler Clog-less burr. They should be placed in the middle between the upper and lower material of the appliance. When putting the holes in the appliance, make sure to angle slightly down to prevent rupturing the bite area. You should not put more than 3 holes in the appliance.

## Note:

1. Make sure to use a Clog-less burr, otherwise the material will melt onto the burr.
